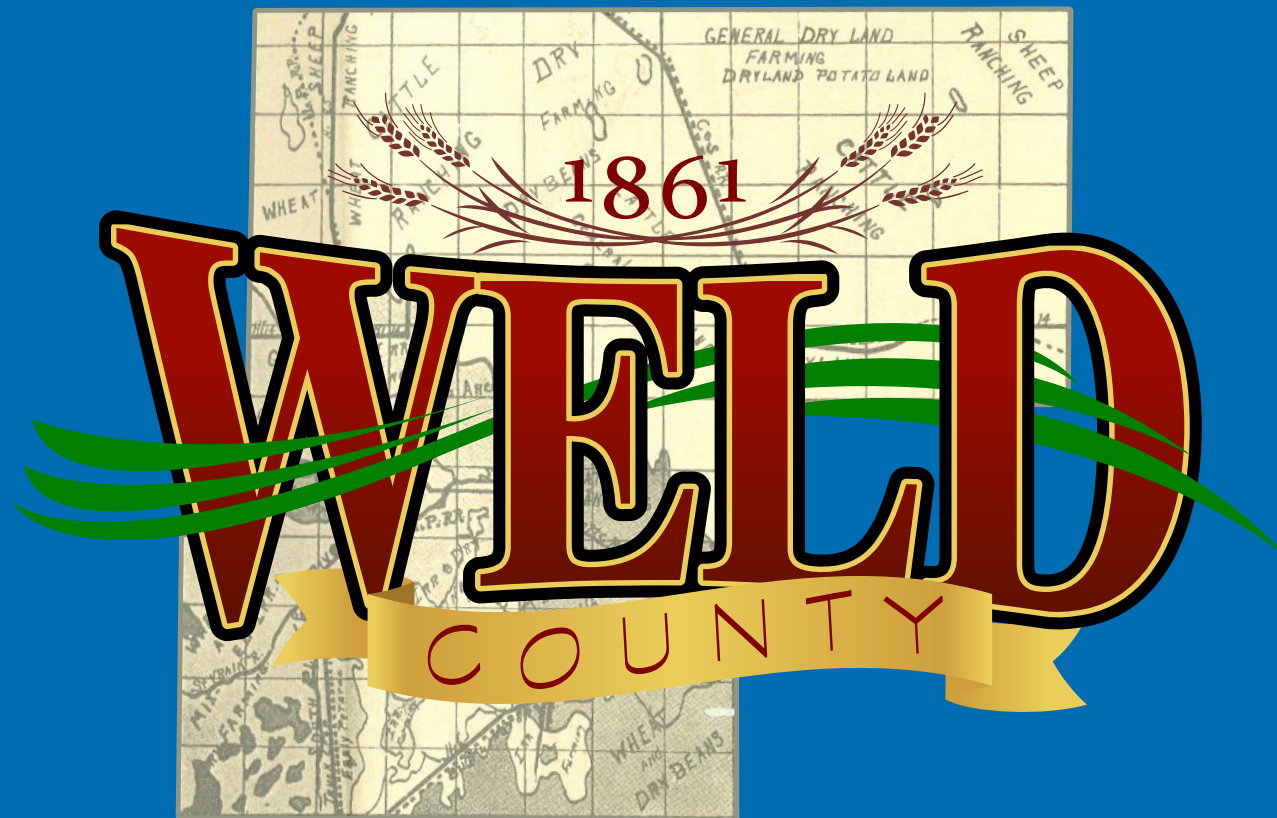

Introduction

We are pleased to present the results of the 2016 Weld County Community Health Survey to the community.

Since 2007, the Community Health Survey has been conducted by the Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment. Every three years a random sample of households is selected by mail to complete the survey. Data collection for 2016 took place from August through October. A total of 2,080 residents completed the survey either on paper or online for a response rate of 25%.

Results from this survey provide county-specific data on health risk behaviors and health status of adult residents in Weld County.

Findings from this survey reported here can be used to:

- Identify priorities and opportunities for new and on-going health initiatives.
- Provide evidence to support positive environmental and system changes related to health locally.
- Increase public awareness of the ways communities, organizations, leaders, and employers can potentially be involved in creating a culture of health for Weld County residents.

This survey is part of the Health Department's continuous effort to understand resident's health and encourage ongoing community dialogue about health issues and concerns through the collection of information and data. 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How to Use This Data Book

Original, recoded, and calculated question responses are included in tables for the common set of eight characteristics outlined below. The Data Book shows how different subgroups responded to the same question on the 2016 survey. The columns (or column sets) in each survey item table can stand alone as a table within the table.

Column Set Name	Description
All Weld	These are the data for all usable responses in the survey and represent countywide estimates.
Region	Data are presented for four regions within Weld County (North, Southwest, Southeast, and Greeley/Evans). Three areas (North, Southwest, Southeast) roughly correspond to political boundaries of the county commissioners. The fourth area corresponds to the municipality boundaries of Greeley and Evans as of 2016. Participant regions are determined by mailing address.
Age	There are three age groups (18-34, 35-54, 55+) presented here, however other adult age groups can be analyzed upon request. Participant ages are determined based on responses to the survey question, <i>“What year were you born?”</i> . Please note that the 2016 CHS is a survey of adults 18 and older, and no respondents are age 17 or younger.
Ethnicity	Participant ethnicities are determined based on responses to the survey question, <i>“Which of the following best describes your racial and ethnic background?”</i> Only Hispanic and non-Hispanic ethnicities are reported for each question due to low responses for other racial and ethnic backgrounds.
Education	Data are presented for four levels of education (less than high school or did not receive high school diploma, High school diploma or G.E.D., Some college with or without an associate’s degree, Bachelor’s degree or higher). These groups are determined based on responses to a survey question.
Income	Data are presented for five levels of household income (less than \$16,000 per year, \$16,000-24,000 per year, \$24,001-48,000 per year, \$48,001-\$80,000 per year, \$80,001 or more per year). These groups are determined based on responses to the survey question, <i>“What was your household’s total income before taxes in 2015?”</i>
FPL Status	Data are presented for households reporting income levels as less than or equal to 100% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) or greater than 100% of the Federal Poverty Level. FPL categories are determined by taking into account the respondents’ reported household size AND their total household income. Categories were created based on Federal Poverty Levels calculated by the Department of Health and Human Services for 2015. Federal Poverty Levels are calculated each year and are often used to determine eligibility for public assistance programs. This threshold defines the poverty population.
Health Insurance	Health insurance status was classified as <i>“yes”</i> or <i>“no”</i> based on responses to the question, <i>“Do you currently have any health care coverage including prepaid plans, such as HMOs, or government plans such as Medicare?”</i>

Reading Across Rows and Down Columns

- For the demographic information on pages 1 to 3, the number in the **“N” column** cells correspond to the total number of responses prior to weighting the data by gender, ethnicity, and age groups. The number in the **“Weighted” column** cells correspond to the number of responses after weighting the data. Comparing the unweighted and weighted cell numbers provides insight about which groups were “up weighted” or “down weighted” to more closely represent Weld County’s population.
- Confidence intervals at the 95% confidence level are also provided for the demographic information. They provide additional insight about how stable the percentage estimate is. For more explanation about confidence intervals, see the next section.
- Unless noted otherwise, the percentages in the columns will total 100% going **down (vertically)** the column (plus or minus about 0.1% due to rounding).
- **Reading across (horizontally)** the rows of tables displays how different groups (region, age, income, etc.) responded.
- When percentages add to 100% for a survey question item, a **“Weighted Total”** is also provided at the bottom of the survey item table. The “Weighted Total” row is the number of usable responses for each subgroup after weighting the data for that question.
- When a question could be answered by providing a count of something (an actual number such as number of vegetables consumed or number of visits to the emergency room), a row displaying the **“mean”** or average (and standard deviation in parentheses) is provided and is typically the bottom row of the table.
- When sample sizes are less than 30 respondents, results were not reported.

Sampling Error/ Confidence Intervals

Sampling error occurs in a survey because a random sample will not exactly reflect the population from which it was drawn. In other words, there can be differences from the true result simply due to chance. Also referred to as the “margin of error” or confidence interval (CI), the sampling error provides an estimated range within which the true value of a number lies. It conveys how precise the measurement is and represents the estimated certainty of a statistic. Confidence intervals (CIs) for a given statistic are partly determined by the size of the sample (i.e., the number of people who answered a particular question). As sample size gets smaller, the plus and minus figures around a given statistic get wider. Also, as the statistic of interest gets closer to the bottom or top values (e.g., nears 1% or 100%) the CI is smaller while the CIs are wider for statistics in the middle (40% to 60%).

Most random sample surveys are designed so that the sampling error range is less than or equal to 5 percentage points from the actual estimate and the confidence level is set at 95% certainty. The 2016 CHS sample was designed so that the width of the sampling error at a 95% confidence level would be ± 2.5 points for countywide estimates and ± 5 points for region level estimates. The actual confidence intervals vary somewhat from these desired ranges due to fluctuating sample sizes among other things. However, the ranges can be used as guides when comparing the health topic results across different sub-groups to assess whether or not differences in two or more estimates reflect “true” versus “chance error” differences. Estimates with confidence intervals and statistical significance tests can be provided by the Health Department upon request. DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY PROCESS

Introduction

In fall 2016, Weld County Department of Public Health & Environment conducted a survey of adults 18 years and older as part of the county’s ongoing health assessment process. The Weld County 2016 Community Health Survey (CHS) was designed to be representative of the county’s population at two levels – countywide and by four sub-regions. The objectives of the CHS were: 1) to assess the health of Weld County residents, 2) to understand the geographic differences in health status within the county, and 2) to investigate if certain population groups were disproportionately more (or less) healthy than other groups.

Survey Instrument

The survey covered a variety of topics such as health, health care access and insurance, children’s health and health coverage, health conditions and habits, preventive screening, environmental issues, health communication issues, community concerns and needs, and demographics. The survey had 55 to 72 questions depending on the version completed (paper vs. on-line). The survey was designed using unimode construction principles (Dillman, 2007). Standardized items were used when possible meaning that the items were based on previously developed health surveys. A back translation method was used to obtain the Spanish version of the survey. All survey versions were pilot tested and revised accordingly. Sample

An address-based sample was obtained from the U.S. Postal Service through a third party vendor. Census geography information including latitude and longitude coordinates for each address was obtained in order to stratify the sample into four regions. Three areas (North, Southwest, Southeast) roughly correspond to political boundaries of Weld County’s commissioner districts. The fourth area corresponds to the municipality boundaries of Greeley and Evans. The sample was further stratified into two dwelling types: a) single family dwelling unit which could be a house or a townhouse, or b) multifamily dwelling unit which could be a duplex or apartment complex. Manufactured homes could be either dwelling type category. Weld County residents that did not have a delivery point addresses

were not contacted. Students living in the University of Northern Colorado’s on-campus housing were not contacted. Manufactured homes and rural route delivery addresses were included. In 2016, ten census tracts in two regions (Southeast, Greeley/Evans) were oversampled to improve representativeness among low income Hispanic neighborhoods.

Data Collection

A total of 8,494 households were contacted. First, a pre-survey letter was mailed to participants in English and Spanish. One week later, participants received a survey booklet which also contained information on how to complete the survey online, as well as how to request a Spanish survey booklet if needed. Two weeks later, all participants received a postcard thanking them for their participation and reminding nonparticipants to complete the survey. The postcard also contained the web address of the online survey and a note for Spanish speakers. Four weeks after the initial survey packet was mailed, a replacement survey booklet was sent to non-respondents. Incentives were not used. Table 1 outlines the final counts for the 2016 survey process. The response rate was 25%.

Weighting and Analysis

Since the inception of the Weld Community Health Survey, data were weighted to produce more reliable estimates. Weighting techniques allow survey samples to be adjusted so that groups that are under- or over-represented in the sample more accurately represent the population. The final assigned weight for each respondent in the dataset indicates how much each respondent will count in statistical procedures. In unweighted datasets, each

respondent represents one person in the population. In weighted datasets, one person may represent more than one individual. Between 2007 and 2013, in addition to initial probability of selection weights and adjustment weights for regional nonresponse patterns, gender, age, Hispanic ethnicity, and county sub-region were used to create weights using traditional post-stratification weighting procedures. Post-stratification weighting forces the proportion of a given demographic subgroup in the sample to match the proportion of that subgroup in the population. In 2016, in addition to selection and nonresponse weights, raking weighting procedures rather than post-stratification procedures were used as the final weight adjustment step with the following variables: gender, age, Hispanic ethnicity, education level, homeowner status, presence of children in the household, and county sub-region. Raking adjusts and then readjusts proportion totals one variable at a time until all seven demographic dimensions in the sample approach that of the population within a pre-set tolerance level of 0.025 percentage points. Adopting raking weighting procedures improved the quality of the data by adjusting on a wider range of demographic characteristics.

Survey Limitations

The Weld Community Health Survey relies on self-reported data which can have certain limitations. For example, respondents may have the tendency to underreport some behaviors that are considered less socially acceptable such as smoking and binge drinking. On the other hand, respondents may over report some behaviors that are more desirable such as physical activity and fruit and vegetable intake. Also, some respondents may have trouble remembering information such as when their blood pressure was last checked. The cross-sectional survey design (rather than experimental design) means causal conclusions are not possible. It should be noted that respondents who could not answer the survey in English or Spanish were not represented in the findings.
